**+Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee**

This Sunday, we commemorate the Publican and the Pharisee. While the Pharisee justified his actions and looked down on the publican, the humble tax-collector could only exclaim “God, be merciful to me, a sinner!”

We do not fast this coming week for two reasons: firstly to fortify ourselves before the coming lent and second so that we do not allow ourselves to become proud, like the Pharisee who boasted that he fasted twice a week.

### **•St Xenia**

On Friday we commemorate St. Xenia, the wanderer of St. Petersburg. This fool-for-Christ was the young widow of an army officer, whose husband died abruptly at a party, without receiving Confession or Communion. She abandoned her own identity, her wealth, and her status and called herself by his name, wore his clothes. Anything good she did, she did in his name. We will have a Molieben on the evening of her feast day.

### **+Святая Ксения**

В пятницу мы совершаем память святой Ксении, странницы Петербургской. Эта Христа ради юродивая была молодой вдовой армейского офицера, муж которого внезапно умер на пиру, не успев принять Исповедь и Причастие. Она отказалась от своей личности, богатства и положения, назвала себя его именем и носила его одежду. Всё доброе, что она делала, она совершала от его имени.
